To register your child/children for Athabasca Summer Programs come to the program office at the Athabasca Regional Multiplex, #2 University Drive!

Registration:

- All fees for Summer Programs MUST be paid + waiver must be signed before your child is registered. If you have not paid your child's fees and the program is full, they will be moved to the waiting list and their spot will be taken by a child that is registered with paid fees.
- Last minute registration will be permitted as long as the space and resources allow it.
- Once wavier has been signed, you can sign your child up for programs and pay via phone

Important notice: A minimum of 10 enrollees are required to run city trips. In the case of a cancellation, an alternative program will be run at the Multiplex at a lower cost.

Early Drop & Late Pick up:
